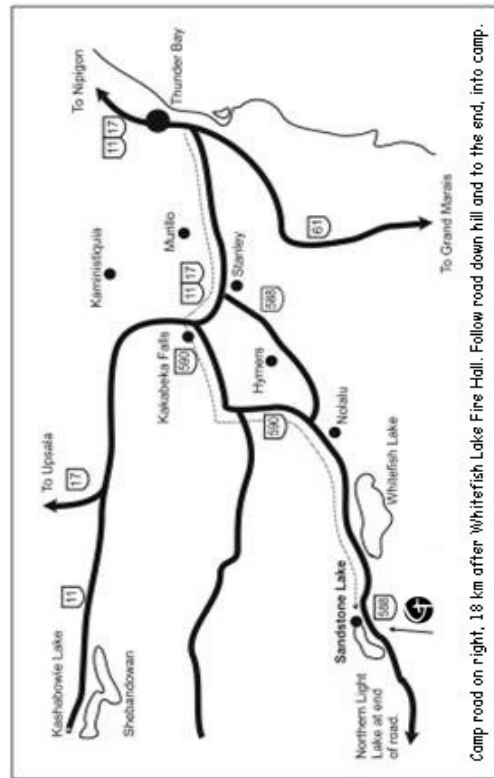
SELECT CAMP by CAMPER AGE THIS YEAR:

Transportation of Campers: Bring your camper out on Sunday afternoon. We send them home by bus on Saturday. Pick-up times/places will be mailed to you & posted on-line.

Getting to Gitchigomee: The Camp is about 100 km from the city, about 4 km past the end of Hwy 588. Watch for the access road at the sign. The road leads to a public campground then to Camp Gitchigomee. **Go slowly: steep grade.**

CAMP FEES

\$225 per camper (by June 1, 2017)

\$250 per camper (after June 1, 2017)

Fees include tuck and bus transportation for the residential camps. Please make cheque or money order payable to "Camp Gitchigomee".

A payment schedule can be arranged, **but full payment is normally required at least two weeks before camp begins.**

Note: Refunds are at the discretion of the Executive Committee and subject to a \$25 administration fee.
